The College of Business Administration of the University of New Orleans (UNO) and the Business and Technology Division of Delgado Community College (Delgado) have signed an agreement that establishes a 2+2 program. This 2+2 program allows students that complete the courses prescribed in Delgado's Business Administration Associate Degree to transfer and leads to a Bachelor of Science Degree from the College of Business Administration at UNO.

## **Delgado 2 UNO Agreement**

### **Program**

Delgado Community College (Delgado) students with an associate degree in Business Administration will be admitted as juniors in the College of Business Administration at the University of New Orleans (UNO) provided they meet UNO's admission requirements. Course requirements for Delgado's associate degree in Business Administration are described on page two of this document.

The total number of credit hours required to complete a bachelor's degree from UNO is 120 semester hours and students can transfer up to 60 semester hours for degree credit from Delgado to UNO. This is a 2+2 program in which Delgado students will earn a bachelor's degree from the University of New Orleans after successfully completing at least 60 additional semester hours in a prescribed major at UNO and meeting all UNO degree requirements.

Delgado students will follow the requirements in the UNO Undergraduate / Graduate Catalog in force at the time they enter Delgado provided it is not over 10 years old and provided there was no break in enrollment of over 5 years.

In order to graduate from UNO, students must complete at least 50% of business courses at UNO and achieve a quality point ratio of 2.0 or better in all work attempted, all work taken at UNO, all business courses, all courses in the major and all courses in the major taken at UNO.

- All students receiving transfer credit for UNO's English 1158 with a "C" or better must validate that
  credit by passing the English Proficiency Examination. The exam must be passed during the first two
  regular semesters of enrollment at UNO.
- Sciences UNO's General Degree Requirements include 11 hours of Science including eight hours of
  one science (two of them laboratory) and three hours of another. One of the sciences must be Biology
  and the other one must be Chemistry, Geology, or Physics. Therefore Delgado students are urged to
  complete the appropriate laboratory courses related to the sciences listed in sections a and b.
  - Two courses from <u>one</u> science (CHEM 141, CHEM 142; GEOL 101, GEOL 102, PHYS 141, PHYS 142; BIOL 101, BIOL 102; or BIO 141, BIOL 142) OR
  - One Biology class (BIOL 101,102,141, 142) and one course from the CHEM, PHYS, or GEOL courses listed above. Note: GEOL from Delgado transfers to UNO as EES (Earth and Environmental Science)
- Students must pass UNO's MANG 3402 with a "C" or better to validate the substitution of Delgado's MANG 201 for UNO's MANG 3401.
