The College of Nursing and Health Sciences at University of Holy Cross (UHC) and the Department of Allied Health at Delgado Community College (DCC) have signed an agreement that establishes a 2+2 program. This 2+2 program allows students who complete the courses prescribed in Delgado's Associate of Applied Science Degree in Respiratory Care Technology to transfer credits to UHC leading to a Bachelor of Science in Health Sciences Degree Curriculum for Respiratory Therapists from University of Holy Cross.

Introduction

The College of Nursing and Health Sciences at the University of Holy Cross and the Division of Allied Health of Delgado Community College (DCC) have signed an agreement renewal which allows students with an Associate of Applied Science Degree in Respiratory Care Technology and the CRT/ RRT credential to be admitted as juniors in the College of Nursing and Health Sciences at University of Holy Cross provided they meet UHC's admission requirements. Credits earned at DCC will be transferred seamlessly to UHC in support of completion of the requirements for a Bachelor of Science in Health Sciences Degree Curriculum for Respiratory Therapists at UHC. Both institutions are accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools and the Commission on Accreditation for Respiratory Care.

UHC Mission Statement

Accreditation Compliance

Both institutions are accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACS-COC) and maintain membership. Both institutions have full-time faculty with advanced academic and professional credentials, and both have support resources (i.e., library, on-line access, service courses, and adequate administrative-faculty-staff backup). DCC accepts responsibility, as does UHC, for ensuring that faculty qualifications are in accordance with SACS-COC standards.

Program

DCC students will be granted admission to UHC to take courses toward completion of the UHC Bachelor of Science in Health Sciences Degree for Respiratory Therapists Program, pending satisfaction of UHC admission requirements. Course requirements are described in

this document. UHC may require students to provide one or more written recommendations prior to acceptance.

The total number of credit hours required to complete a Bachelor of Science in Health Science Degree for Respiratory Therapists at UHC is 120 semester hours. Students can transfer up to 66 semester hours for degree credit from DCC to UHC. Thirty-two of those credit hours must include clinical courses in satisfaction of the clinical component of the Respiratory Care Program. (See page two)

DCC students will follow the requirements in the UHC Undergraduate Catalog in force at the time they entered DCC provided the Catalog is not over ten years old. There shall be no break in student enrollment over five years.

In order to graduate from UHC, students must complete at least 25% of the total number of credit hours within the degree program at UHC. Students must maintain a minimum gradepoint average of 2.0 overall.

Program Evaluation

Representatives of UHC and DCC agree to meet while the agreement is in effect to evaluate the performance of students who engage in clinical and didactic training at the DCC location. Communication initiated by either party may take place at any time during the agreement viain-person meetings, telephone, or in writing.

Program Renewal

This agreement shall be renewed every five years from the date of signing and will be continued, modified, or terminated upon mutual agreement of the parties. Termination of the agreement requires ninety-day notification: students enrolled at the time of termination will be allowed to complete the program.
