The Semiannual Security Report and new reporting requirements contain statistics covering **April 2022 – September 2022**. The crime statistics chart includes Clery Act data and information related to statistics of incidents of power-based violence (any form of interpersonal violence intended to control or intimidate another person through the assertion of power over the person). It includes but is more expansive than sexual misconduct and Title IX misconduct.
