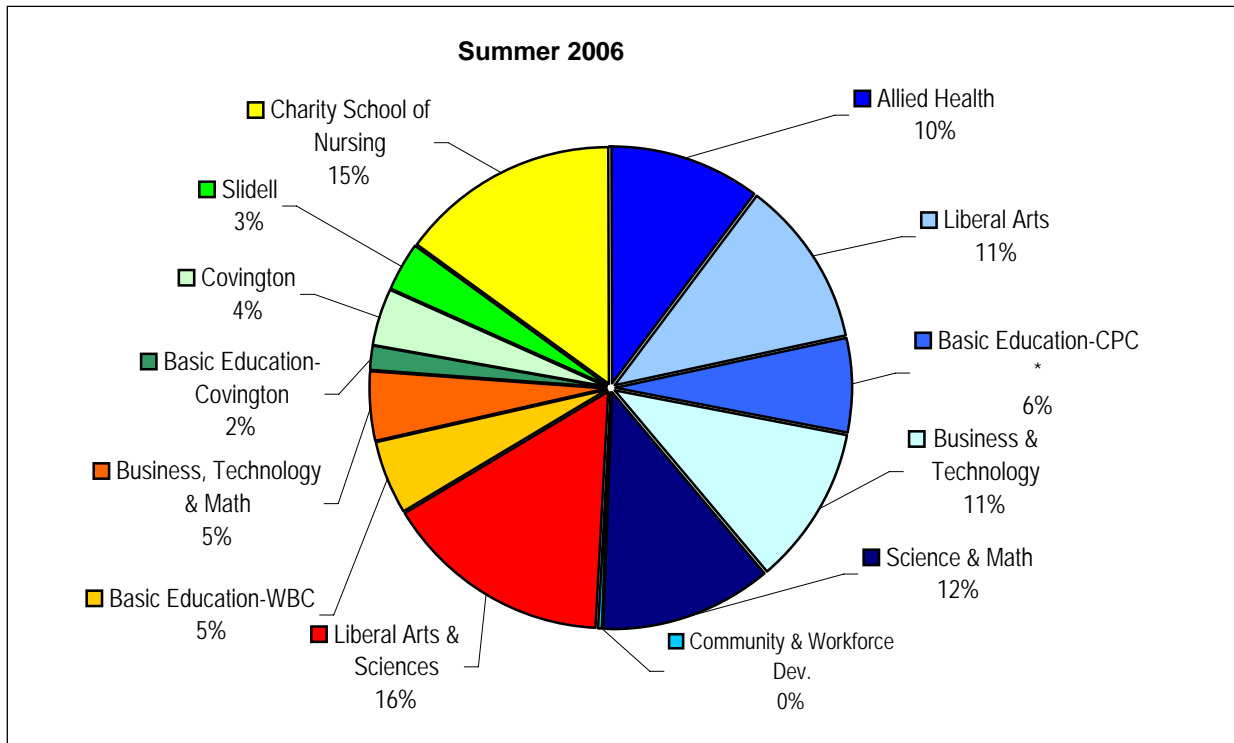

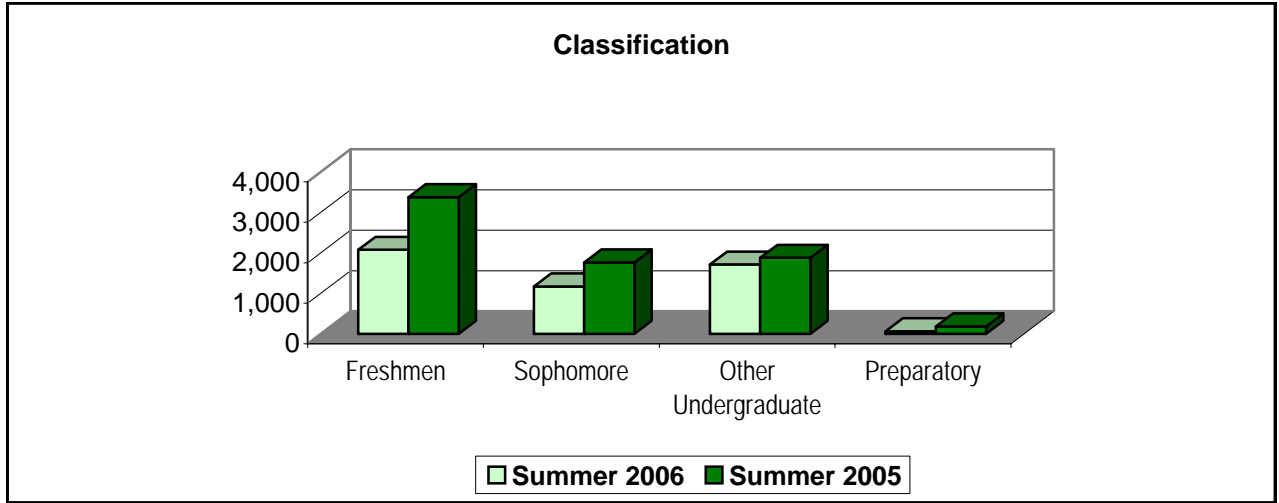
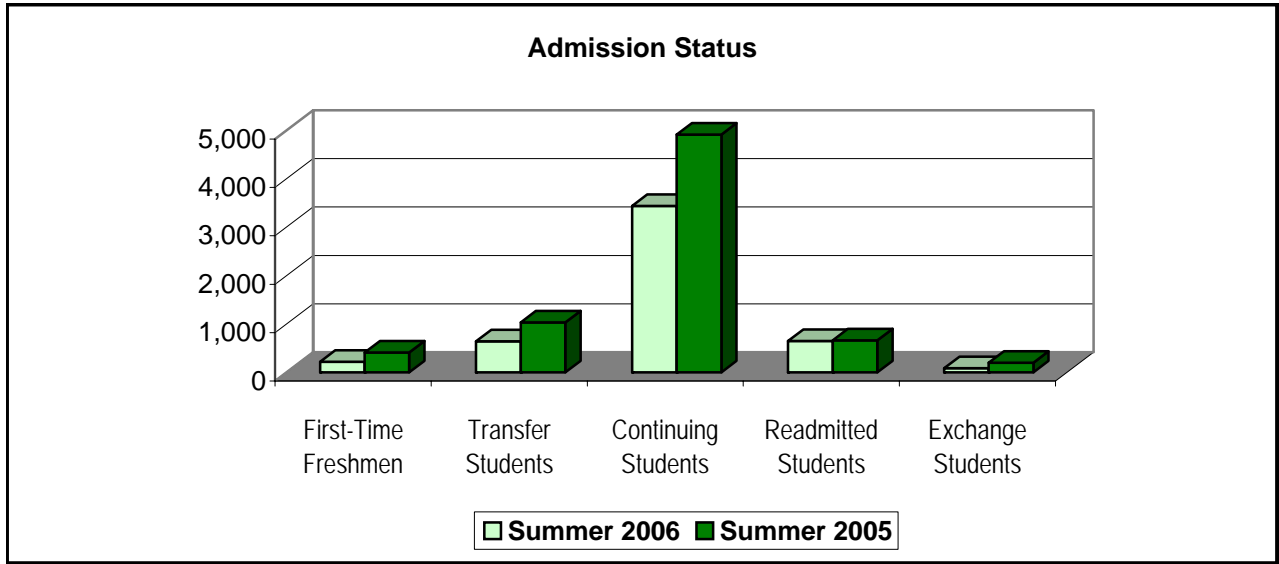
Enrollment by Division

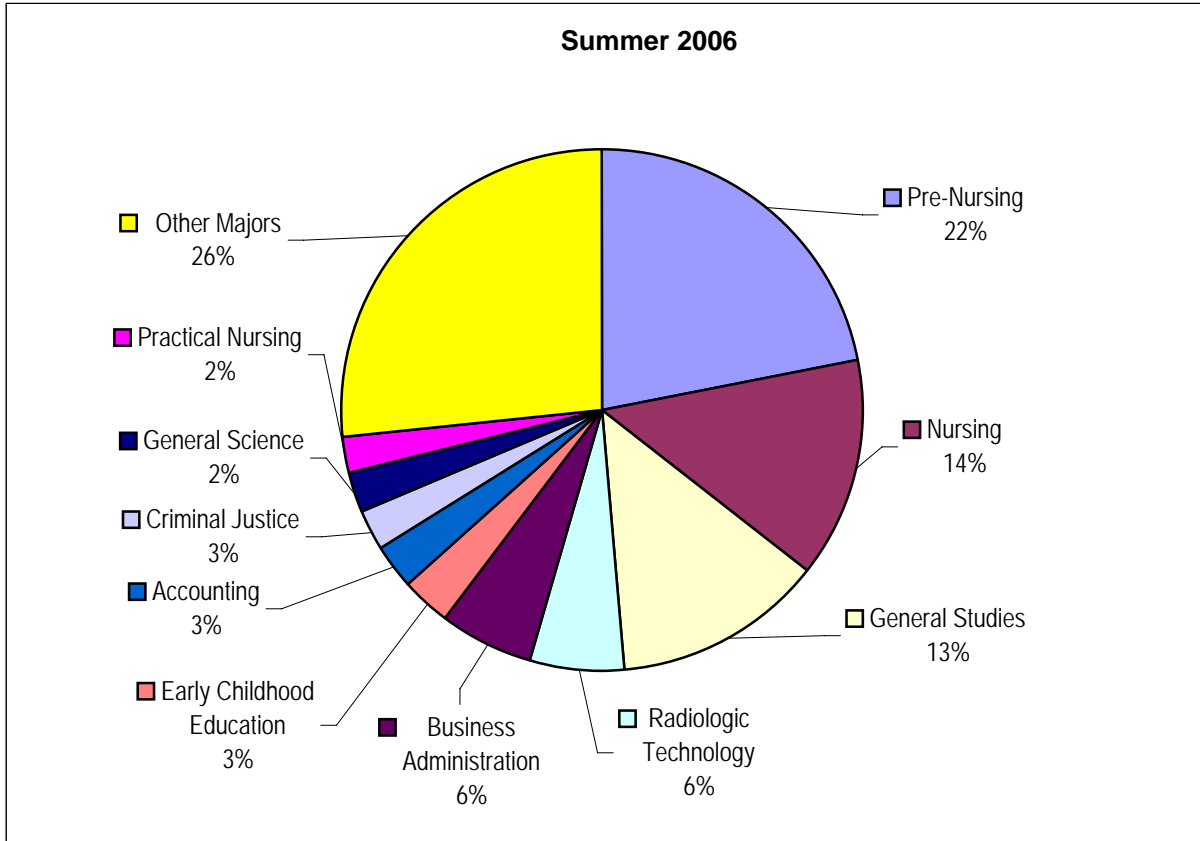
