NOTE: A student is not included in the retained column once they have graduated. Also, the graduated columns are cumulative. NOTE: A student is considered retained if they are retained in any part of the subsequent year. For example, a student in 2006 - 2007 is considered retained if they are enrolled at any point in 2007 - 2008.

NOTE: Delgado has a later entry cohort than the other three as IR does not start tracking a two-year institution's cohorts unless the institution has at least 10 members in that cohort or unless the institution requests tracking.

NOTE: Students are only tracked for four years. Any retention and/or degrees awarded after that point are not included.
