SUMMARY

Academic Year 2023-24 Job Placement

<u>Report Methodology</u>: the following pages display job placement outcomes for graduates of terminal-award, job-ready programs, who did not remain enrolled at Delgado after graduating. Results are shown by program (p.2-3) and by industry sector (p.4-5). A student is counted as placed in a job if they had payroll earnings in the State of Louisiana within two quarters of graduating, as reported by the Louisiana Workforce Commission (LWC).

Notable Outcomes:

- 64.4% of AY 2023-24 graduates obtained confirmable employment in the time window analyzed.
- The top 5 programs with the highest numbers of employed graduates were: Registered Nursing (194), Business & Management (37), Radiologic Technology (37), Accounting (36), and Electrician (25).
- The top 5 industry sectors in which graduates obtained employment were: Hospitals (255), Food/Drink Service (46), Ambulatory Health Care Services (37), Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services (24), and Administrative and Support Services (21).

<u>Report Limitations</u>: Employment status cannot be confirmed for graduates who are self-employed, or who are employed in other states, or in military service. The outcomes reported here make no indication regarding the specific job the graduate obtained.
