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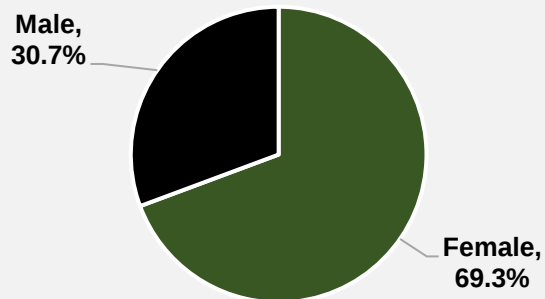
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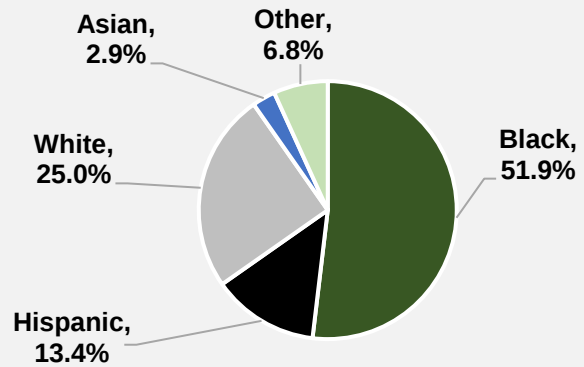
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Percentage of Total Enrollment Headcount by Gender

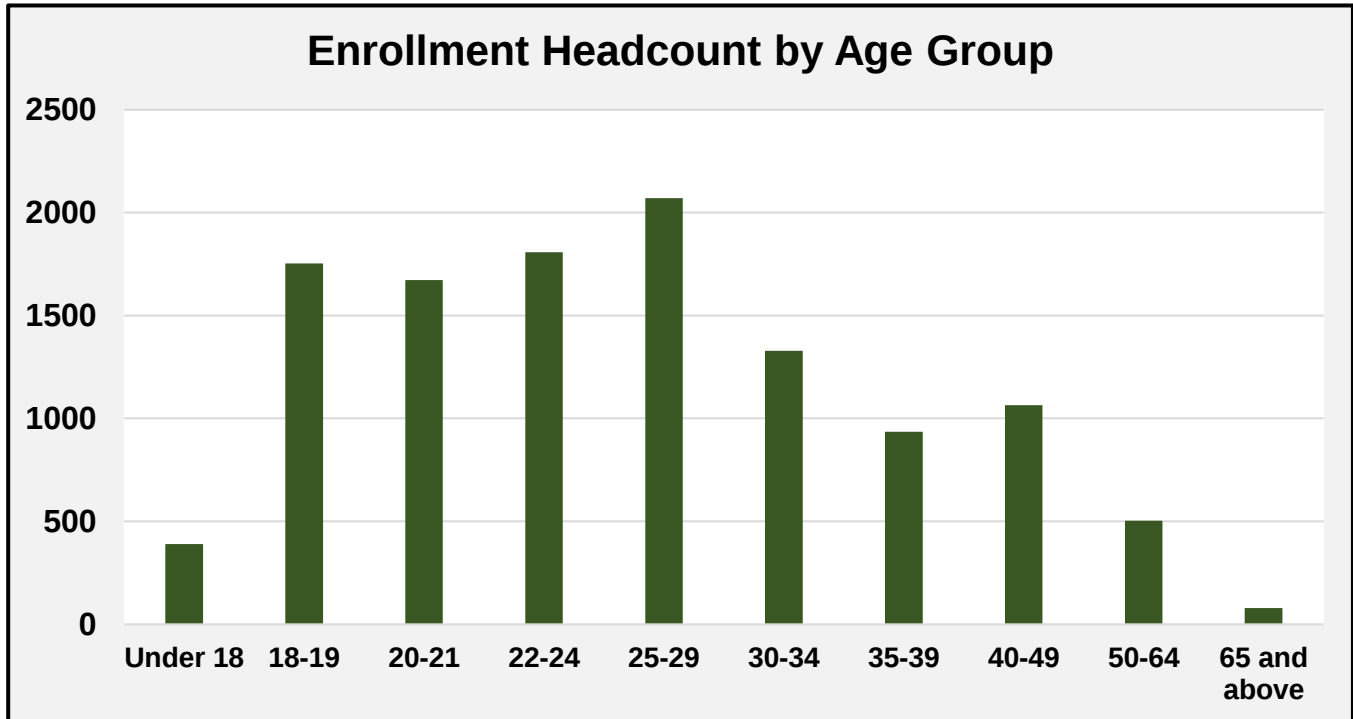


Percentage of Total Enrollment Headcount by Race

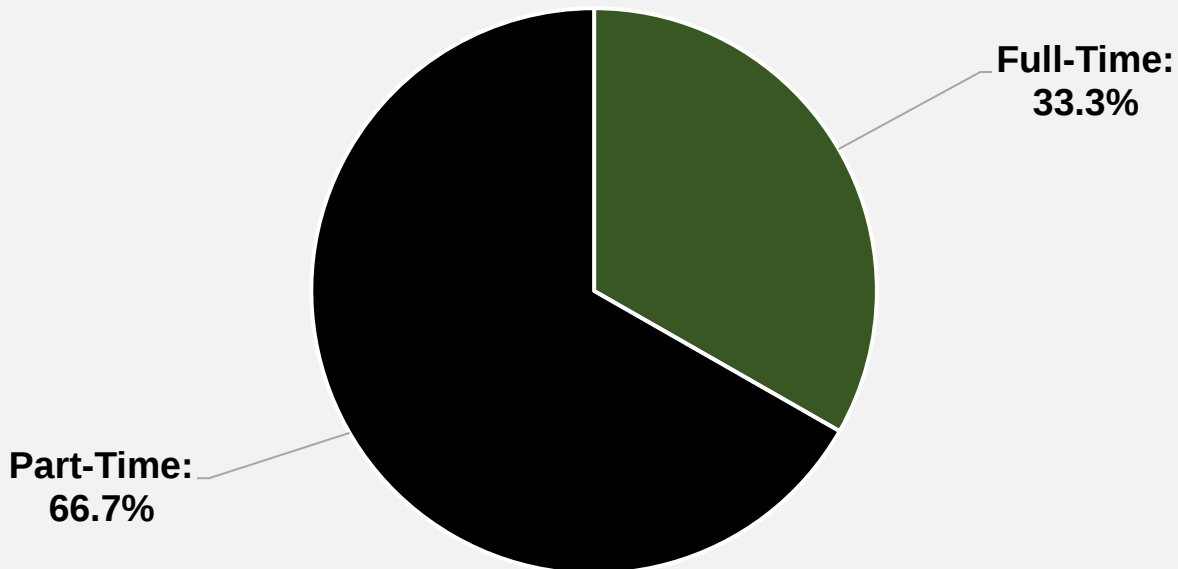

Percentage of Total Enrollment Headcount by Full-Time/Part-Time Status

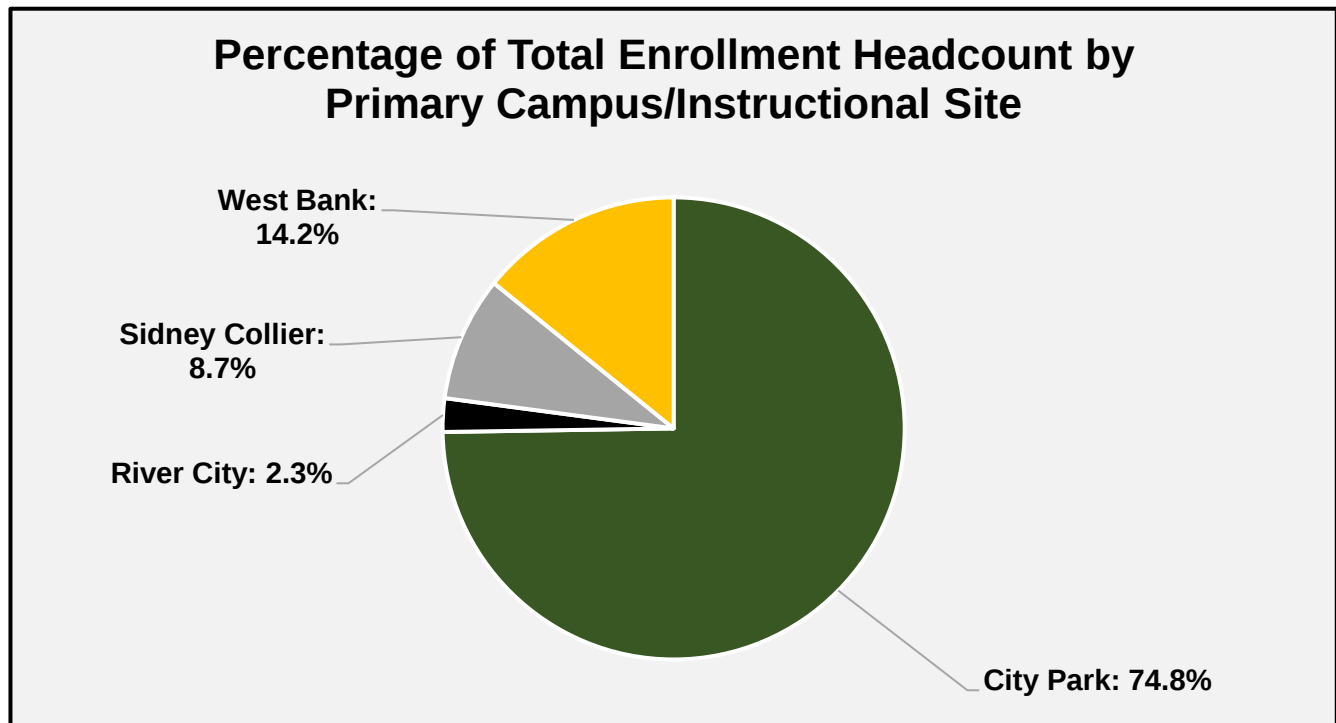

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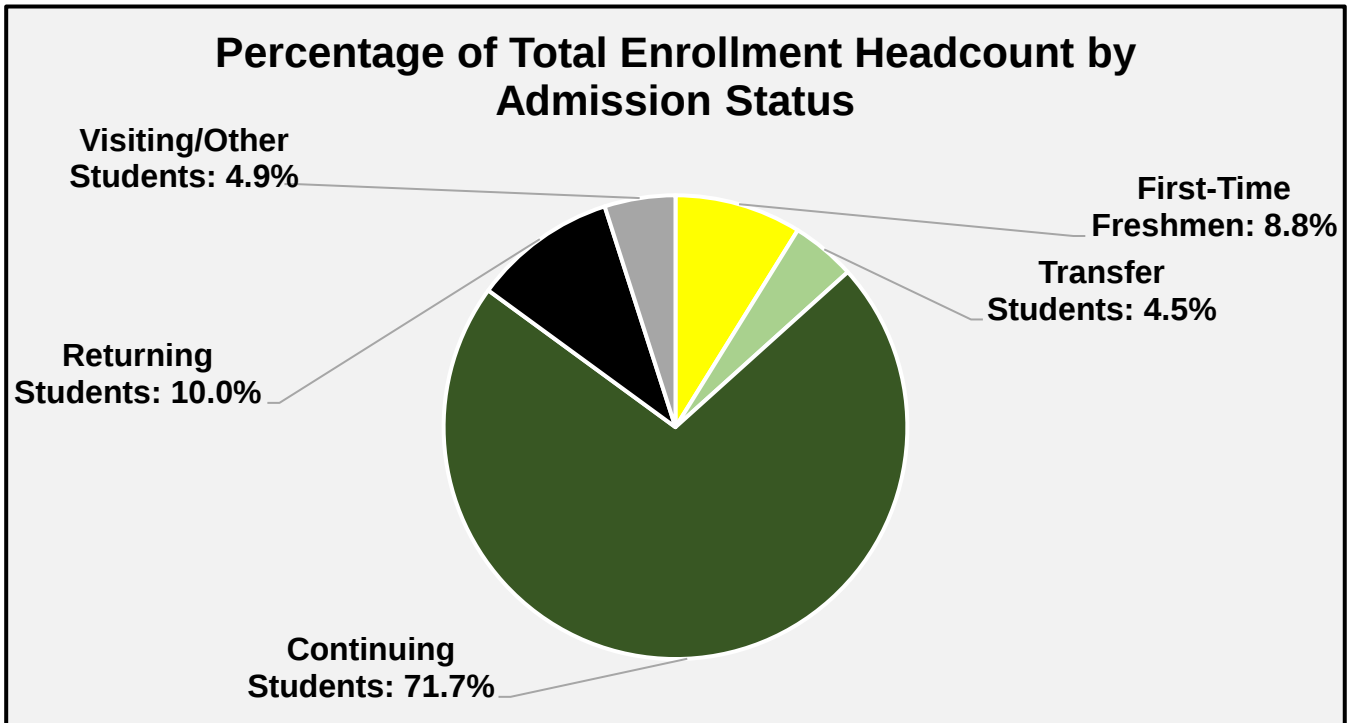

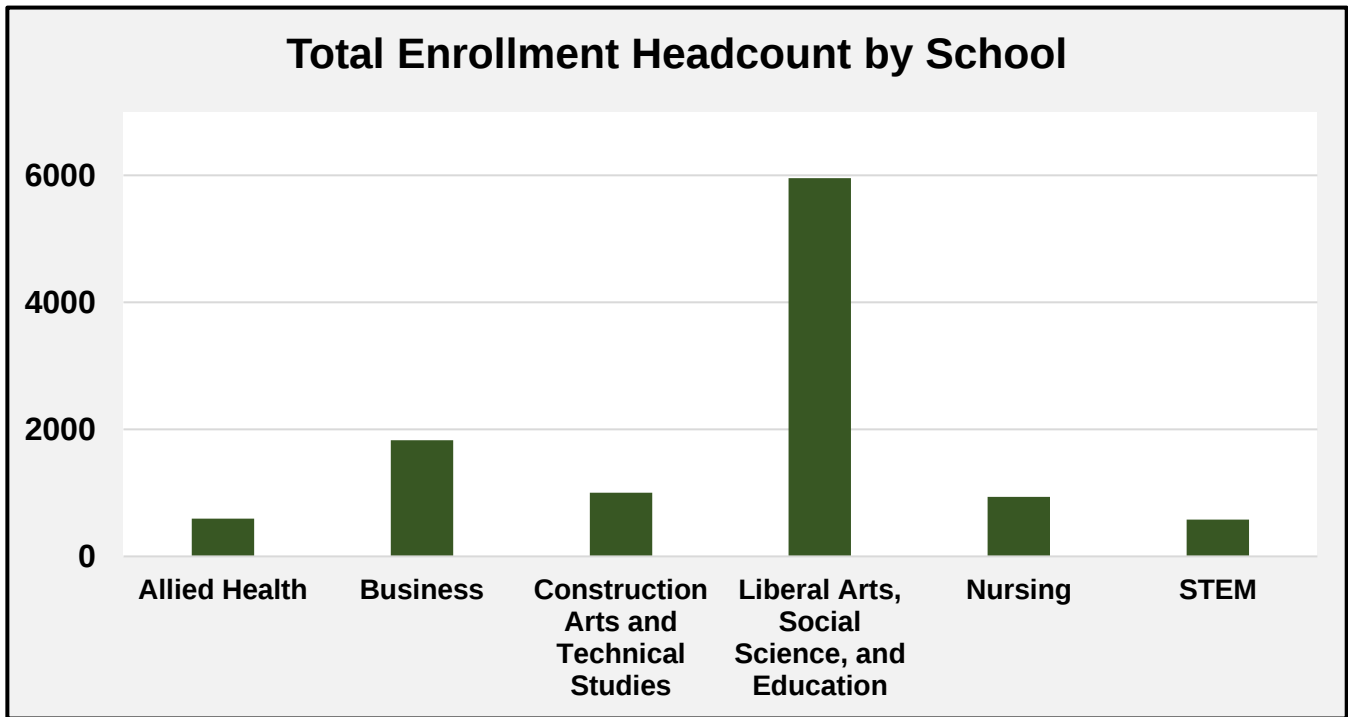
