SUMMARY

AY 2023-24 Students Transferred to Four-Year Institutions as of Year-End, AY 2024-25

Report Methodology: following LCTCS convention, a student is counted as transferring to a four-year university if they are enrolled at Delgado in one academic year (July 1 - June 30), and enrolled at a four-year university during the next academic year. All transfer enrollment data is retrieved via National Student Clearinghouse search. Delgado enrollment data is drawn from the Statewide Student Profile System (SSPS) official census reported to Board of Regents.

Notable Data and Trends:

AY 2024-25 saw a notable increase in the number of Delgado students transferring to four-year institutions. 2,481 students transferred to a four-year institution, compared to 2,352 in the previous year.

The top five transfer destinations for Delgado students were 1. LSU (any LSU system school), 2. University of New Orleans, 3. University of Louisiana, Lafayette, 4. Southeastern Louisiana University, and 5. Chamberlain University.

1,696 of the total 2,481 students transferring to a four-year university went to an institution in Louisiana.
